MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF BIG BEAR MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT HELD ON THURSDAY, September 5, 2024

1. OPEN SESSION

President Ludecke opened the regularly scheduled Board meeting at 1:00 PM at the Big Bear Municipal Water District located at 40524 Lakeview Drive, Big Bear Lake, CA 92315 on Thursday September 5, 2024.

4. REPORTS

A. Jared Cheek, General Manager reported that we met with FOBBV, reviewed comments on the current environmental effort, and it went well. Coast Guard Aux reached out about getting back out on the lake to help with boater safety and assisting with tows on Holiday weekends, so we are hoping to bring that back. President Ludecke asked about the lake video, Mr. Cheek responded yes, but nothing new to report. The new TMDL boat is now here, going to be retrofitted over the winter. We treated a couple green spots prior to Labor Day. The lake was busy this weekend but tapered off. Met the new lieutenant at the sheriff's station. Jim Teel won our Countin' Carp Incentive Program with 657 fish, and Brayden Black was our raffle winner. They get to decide what prize they would like. Director Braford asked some questions about the Countin' Carp Incentive Program and what he would like to see for next year continuing this effort. He added that it seems better than the carp tournament at this point. West ramp is closed for the season and east ramp is now at reduced hours, daily 7am -3pm and KOOL Kids event is coming up Sept 24 and 25.

B. Mike Stephenson, Chief Operations Officer, reported August 23 was the flip prediction, which turned out to be a little off, it almost flipped, but then it started cooling down, so we have not seen that yet. Lake has changed about 2 degrees, so it's restrat'ing. So, we are still stratified as of today. Dissolved Oxygen (DO) from top to bottom is 8 to 2, we're very layered. There is 4-degree difference from top to bottom. President Ludecke asked about the lake dropping less than 3 feet is summer, is that correct? Mr. Stephenson confirmed that is correct, the groundwater movement is real, and that is what helped us leading to the reduction from our average summer loss.
